ST. TAMMANY HOLIDAY FESTIVAL OF ARTS RULES & PROCEDURES:

1. St. Tammany Holiday Festival of Arts is a Shop Local Artist Week event produced by Northshore Cultural Economy Coalition, a collaborative effort of artists, arts organizations and cultural economy businesses working together to promote the arts and grow the cultural economy. The festival is open to St. Tammany based artists and arts organizations. Booths for arts organizations and cultural economy organizations are provided by invitation only. Booths for visual artists are provided via a jurying process. Participation is limited to invited organizations and artists only; no additional vending opportunities are available.

BOOTH FEES:

\$35 for single artist/organization

\$60 for two artists/organizations sharing a tent (maximum two)

2. All artwork must be original and completed by the artist(s) registering for the booth.

3. Due to space limitations and to ensure the integrity of the festival, artists will be selected via a juried process. Not all submitted applications will be accepted. The application deadline is November 15. Artists will be notified of jury results no later than Nov. 20.

4. Jury process: artist selections will be made by the Northshore Cultural Economy Coalition jury committee. We are looking for a diverse selection of media, and we will choose artists based on the total number of entries per category and by the supplied information as best as possible.

5. Upon confirmation of acceptance, the exhibition fee must be received no later than Nov. 28, 2017 or participant will forfeit space. The only forms of payment which can be accepted are checks or money orders. Please make payable to Northshore Cultural Economy Coalition and mail to P O Box 3343, Slidell, LA 70459 or deliver to St. Tammany Art Association, 320 N Columbia St., Covington, LA. (Please note that STAA is closed on Sundays and Mondays.) There will be no refunds for cancellation by the artist or organization.

6. This is an outdoor festival. The rain date for this event is Saturday, December 9, noon to 5 pm. Artists/participants are responsible for checking the website, www.ShopLocalArtistsWeek.com or [Facebook.com/ShopLocalArtistsWeek](https://www.facebook.com/ShopLocalArtistsWeek) for cancellation notices. Participants will NOT receive individual notifications. Cancellation decisions will be made no later than 8 am the day of the event.

7. All artists and organizations are renting space only. Participants are responsible for providing tents, tables, chairs and any required display systems. **Only white 10x10 tents are allowed.** No electricity will be available.

8. Artists are required to contain all displays and artwork to within the allocated 10x10 space.

9. Art vendors agree to sell artwork only—no food, promotional, or personal merchandise.

10. All booth spaces are assigned. If you request that your booth be located next to another artist, we will try our best to accommodate, but we will not guarantee it.

11. All artists are responsible for collecting and remitting appropriate sales tax.

12. Set up will take place on Sunday, December 3, 10 am to 11:30 am. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE OUT OF THE FESTIVAL AREA NO LATER THAN 10:30 AM. Street and lot parking is available throughout the downtown Covington area.

13. All participants must check-in at the festival information booth prior to set up. Setup must be completed no later than 11:30 a.m.

14. Participants may NOT begin dismantling their booths until the section area of the festival closes at 5 pm. Participants must remain with their booths until that time.

15. St. Tammany Holiday Festival of Arts is a family friendly event. The festival jury has the right to reject any art deemed inappropriate.

16. St. Tammany's Holiday Festival of Arts is presented with the support of the City of Covington, St. Tammany Art Association and CEC members and volunteers. This event is supported by a grant from the Louisiana Division of the Arts, Office of Cultural Development, Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism, in cooperation with the Louisiana State Arts Council, and as administered by the St. Tammany Commission on Cultural Affairs, St. Tammany Parish Government. Funding has also been provided by the National Endowment for the Arts, Art Works.

17. This event is organized entirely by a team of volunteers working together to support artists and arts organizations. Participants are expected to be respectful of our volunteers' time and talents, and to treat the festival team, participants and festival visitors with courtesy and respect.

18. The festival organizers and producers, Northshore Cultural Economy Coalition, City of Covington and its employees, volunteer staff will not assume liability for loss, damage, or injury to anyone participating in the St. Tammany Holiday Festival of Arts, nor for the loss of any property. If insurance is desired, it must be secured by the participating artist/organization.

19. We are not responsible for lost or misdirected submissions.

20. Please carefully read and complete the application – incomplete applications may be rejected. Completed applications may be emailed to Jury@ShopLocalArtistsWeek.com, with appropriate work samples if applicable. Applications also may be delivered to St. Tammany Art Association at 320 N Columbia St., Covington, LA.

Presented by Senator Sharon Hewitt and Representative Greg Cromer, Senate Concurrent Resolution 20 recognizes the first full week of December as Shop Local Artists Week statewide. It passed without opposition in both the House and Senate on April 25, 2017.
